Pedrito Maynard-Reid - Graduate of the Class of 1970



Pedrito Maynard-Reid is Assistant to the President of Walla Walla University for Diversity. He was the Vice President for Spiritual Life and Mission at Walla Walla College for 10 years prior to this appointment. He has also been Professor of Biblical Studies and Missiology in the School of Theology since 1990.

For 15 years he served at [his alma mater] Northern Caribbean University in Jamaica in a number of capacities, including Professor of Biblical Studies, Chair of the Department of Religion, Director of Religious Affairs, and Pastor of the University Church. He also served in similar positions in Puerto Rico, at Antillian University in the late 1980s. In addition to his theological training, Pedrito is an accomplished musician with degrees in piano performance from Schools of Music in the United Kingdom.

He is the author of many publications. His published books include: Poverty and Wealth in the Epistle of James (Orbis Press); A Commentary on the Epistle of James (Pacific Press); Complete Evangelism (Herald Press); and Diverse Worship: African American, Caribbean & Hispanic Perspectives (Inter Varsity Press). He is one of the authors of the Andrews Study Bible; and is presently writing another commentary on James for the SDA International Bible Commentary series to be published by the Review and Herald Publishing Association.

Training & Core competencies:

- BSc degree in Computer/ Information Science
- Good working knowledge of programming languages including C, Visual Basic, PCU, PHP, SPL, ASP, JAVA, JAVA Script
- Knowledge of a broad range of relevant multi user computer systems and application
- Thorough knowledge of MS SQL and Oracle database functionalities and architecture

- Thorough knowledge of financial systems, desktop and network operations

3. Uses programming languages to code computer instructions from the systems documentation. Utilises any special programming techniques necessary to achieve the most effective programme
4. Advises and works with user units to resolve specific problems or make changes in programmes, computer applications, capabilities, and alternative programming approaches
5. Writes and maintains documentation to describe programme development, logic, coding, testing, changes, and corrections
6. Implements and manages an e-commerce solution for the Philatelic Unit
7. Ensures that all software applications are functional and properly secured and backed up at the head office and throughout the post offices. Tests and debugs computer programmes as necessary
8. Assists in creating software policies and user guidelines
9. Manages and assists in the maintenance of the Website and Intranet Systems and Audit Software used throughout the Post Offices
10. Assists in the design of special forms and flowcharts as needed by:
 - a. liaising with the various units and system administrator regularly to identify computerization needs and determines how the desired results can be achieved
